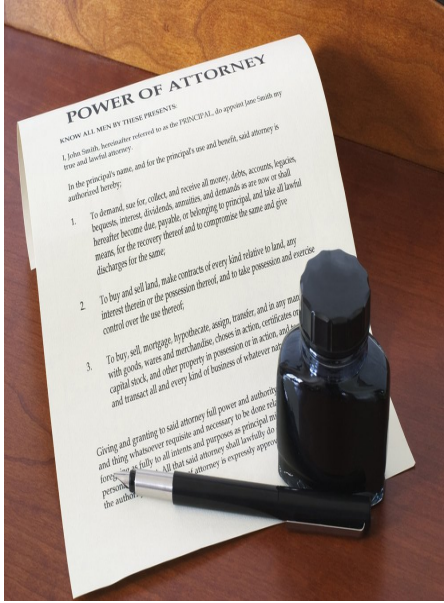

Appointment of Agents to Control Disposition of Remains

The Prominent family has a mausoleum and family plot for all descendants. Rosalyn Prominent Smith is the daughter of Tom and Karen Prominent. She was married and had children with her husband, Scott Smith. Should she be buried with her husband Scott Smith or her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Prominent?

Some people find it useful to appoint a specific person to handle matters concerning a decedent's remains and to set forth their specific wishes. This can be done by an Appointment of Agent to control Disposition of Remains.

Maria's oldest son wants to cremate her remains. Her daughter is opposed and wants her body buried in the family plot. What do they do?

This legal instrument allows the principal to disclose pre-funded pre-needed ("advance") agreements for funeral merchandise or services.

It also allows special directions to be set forth. This can be useful in situations where there have been multiple marriages or family plots. It can also clarify wishes regarding organ donation, cremation, autopsy and other personal decisions about the eternity of your remains.

Mary was widowed in her 30's with 2 children. She remarried and had another 2 children with her second husband. Her family has differing opinions as to whether she would want to be buried with her first husband or with her current husband.

After retirement, John moved to Florida with his second wife of 20 years. His children all live in New York. The children want him buried in New York but his wife wants him buried in Florida. They both want to visit the grave.
